December, was a special month for our family and ministry. During the Christmas season, our children had the opportunity to participate in the Christmas programs of two different churches close to where we serve. As parents, there is something deeply moving about watching your children serve the Lord!

God continues to work in a great way in Toluca, Mexico. We are encouraged by the growth we see in the churches and in the men being trained for ministry. Looking ahead, we are currently planning a graduation for March of this year, celebrating what God has done in the lives of students who have faithfully prepared themselves for the work of the ministry. It is a joy to see God raising up servants who desire to shepherd His people faithfully.

We are also rejoicing in what God is doing beyond Mexico. In the West Indies, a church that we had the privilege of helping start in 2018 has now, by God's grace, planted another church in 2025. Watching churches multiply and take ownership of the Great Commission is a powerful reminder that God's work continues far beyond one location or one generation.

As we reflect on the years of ministry, we are humbled by what God has done through the first church we helped start—New Life Baptist Church in 2014. From that single church, the Lord has allowed seven churches to be started around the world. From these works, **five men have been called to pastor**, and **three have surrendered to serve as missionaries.** We love walking beside men whom God has called and investing in their lives as they serve God's people. It is a privilege we never take lightly.

This season is also significant for our mission board. **Frontier Baptist Missions is celebrating 75 years of God's faithfulness, and Lord willing, we will reach 100 missionaries with the board this month.** What a testimony to God's grace and to churches faithfully sending laborers into the harvest.

In addition, **Trinity Baptist Seminary continues to grow in remarkable ways.** We now have 40 extensions in five continents, training men and women to rightly divide the Word of God and serve faithfully in their local churches. Seeing pastors and leaders trained around the world reminds us that God is building His church in every place.

As January began, training and classes resumed with renewed vision and momentum. We continue to see a hunger in those who desire to be equipped for faithful service. As we look ahead to the rest of this year, we are keenly aware that much can be done—but we desperately need the Lord's help.

Thank you for your faithful prayers and support. You are a vital part of every church planted, every student trained, and every life touched.
