Dear Friends,

“Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ.” (Philippians 1:6) We had a wonderful start to the new year with a week-long trip to Cape Coast, where we visited missionaries Miguel and Nora Triano, along with their dedicated team and several local pastors. Their sacrifice and strong desire to reach Deaf individuals with the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ was a great encouragement to our hearts.

During our time there, we conducted classes on how to witness to the Deaf. We rejoice that ten Deaf individuals trusted Christ as their Saviour, and one Deaf man followed the Lord in believer’s baptism. Pastor Triano, Pastor Elisha, and Pastor Anafo graciously opened their pulpits to us, showing their genuine burden for the Deaf community. It was a blessing to see many church members and leaders learning to sign, offering interpreted services, and even having a Deaf man, Bosomtwe, teach a Sunday school class for the Deaf.



After spending time with Pastor Anafo and witnessing Bosomtwe’s faithfulness, we felt led to invest further in his spiritual growth through dedicated Bible teaching and training. He now travels to meet with us each week for instruction and then returns to Cape Coast to continue serving in his local New Testament church. We are grateful for the opportunity to partner with these local pastors and look forward to continued ministry together in the future.

As we provide dedicated Bible teaching and training in a more formal Bible institute setting, we are finding that many Deaf sincerely lack basic reading comprehension. We are grateful for God’s leading in establishing our Deaf school and for the dedicated staff who faithfully teach these children to read, study, and understand the Bible. We also rejoice that one of our students, Kwaku, recently understood the Gospel and placed his faith in Christ alone for salvation. If we are to reach the Deaf in Ghana for generations to come, we must remain diligent in teaching Deaf individuals of all ages to read and comprehend God’s Word.

In March, we celebrated our 9th anniversary as a church. We give God all the glory for the incredible impact this ministry has made in His Kingdom and within the Deaf community here in Ghana. Through every high and low, one thing has remained constant—God is able, and He is faithful. We step into this next chapter with excitement and expectation, trusting Him for even greater growth and impact in the life of this ministry.

Please pray for me and my two older sons as we travel to South Africa. Missionary Chris Radebaugh has invited me to preach at the 30th Anniversary service of the Bible Baptist Church of the Deaf at the end of April. I’m grateful for this opportunity and ask that you pray that the Lord will use us to be a blessing, encouraging more Deaf men to preach the Gospel.

I’ll be sharing updates on our building progress along the way. It’s truly exciting to see how the Lord is guiding and providing at every stage. This entire journey has been about more than constructing a building—it’s been about strengthening our faith and reliance on God as a church. We serve a good, good God!
