Because of the severe flood, I and my church members as well as my community have moved to a safe place. We were able to move by His grace while many people have gone missing under the flood water. As of today, we heard that more than 200 people have died and are missing and more and more flood victims are suffering and struggling. We learned that the death rates will be higher. So, we are so sad about it in the middle of the on-going war. So, please pray and consider helping us as we are in desperate need of help. What we urgently need is food, drinking water, blankets and mosquito nets etc. (at about \$100 each. brb) By seeing the needs, I plan to help at least 175 (\$17,500) families who are so poor and in need of help. Thank you for your prayers!

#950431 Hung Ma Na: After the Lashio city was captured by mnnda (good guys running out the bad guys), the people are warned to leave the city in order to escape from the airstrike by the junta (bad guys/military) (pictures below). More and more refugees came to our place and many of them were suffering and struggling for their daily food. I am burdened by their suffering and I started praying to God to provide funds to help those refugees as they are desperately in need of help. Our plan is to help

at least 170 families who are so poor and have no Christ in their lives, so that many people hear the good news of salvation in their lives. I have some contacts already and have shared the Gospel with a few people. Our plan is to help each family with a 25 kg bag of rice which costs us 115,000 MMK (@ 5,044 {hyper-inflation} = \$1.00 USD = \$22.80) . The food is increasing every day since all roads are blocked from cities like Mandalay and Yangon. So, please pray for God's provision to help 170 refugee families as my estimated cost reached 199,550,000 MMK (\$3,876). Thank you for joining us in your prayers!

#950426 Pum Sian Hang: The place where I live in Tamu has been totally cut off from Kalay since the past two years and prices are higher than the other places. The situation is also very bad all the time and more and more people are suffering and struggling. Many people from many villages came to the town of Tamu for the safety of their lives but they have no job to earn money. I saw their physical needs as well as their spiritual needs since the need to hear the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Also, most of my church members are also suffering and they need help for their daily food. For this need, I prayed to God to provide funds to help at least 145 refugee families who are in desperate need of help. So please join me in prayer for this need so that the Gospel will be spread among these people who never heard it in their lives before. So, my plan is to help one family with a bag of rice. It costs us about 225,000 (@5,044 - \$44.61) = per(50 kg) bag of rice x 145 = \$6,468 . Thank you for joining me in your prayers to meet this need.

My wife has been suffering from piles since she was affected with Covid 19. It has worsened and now, she has been hospitalized since Wednesday. Now, she has to go for Hemorrhoids surgery and her operation is scheduled for the next early morning. Pray that everything will go well and that the Lord will provide for her hospital expenses, as the estimated cost according to the doctor is about 5.5 million MMK (@ 5,044 = \$1.00 USD = \$1,090) .
