Dear Faithful Prayer Partner,

“And he said unto them, *Let us go into the next towns, that I may preach there also: for therefore came I forth.*” While driving to update one of our supporting churches in New England on a Sunday morning, I was listening to my daily devotional when this verse grabbed my attention. The Holy Spirit spoke to my heart, indicating that this should be the theme verse for 2026 for the ministry **He** has entrusted to us. From a Scriptural viewpoint, this verse reveals the mission of the **Master: He** gives a **directive** with a clear **destination**, showing us His **desire** and **determination** to reach the next town. Consequently, this has become our theme for 2026. When we transitioned to New England in September 2020, we had no idea what we would be able to accomplish. Yet, over the last five years, we have seen **God** perform miraculous things here and within the prisons. We have seen God open doors that no man could, save souls, and change lives. We are excited to see what God will continue to do as we strive to go to the **“next town”** this year.

Family: On the family front, things are moving just as fast as the ministry! Titus finished up fifth grade with flying colors and has already launched into his sixth-grade work; he even got to sing a special in our church’s Christmas cantata. Timothy is chattering away in full sentences and doing a great job recognizing his colors, while Matthew Jr. is now standing without assistance—we know he will be walking (and running) very soon. We had a wonderful Christmas, and Hannah and I were truly overwhelmed by the love shown to us; thank you to those who sent in extra gifts. Of course, life never stays quiet for long. We received word in December that our landlord is transitioning our current house into workforce housing, so we are gearing up to move the family shortly after this letter goes out. Fun times!

Ministry: December was a month filled with opportunities to preach and present the ministry. I was given the opportunity to preach chapel at New England Baptist College and present the ministry opportunities of Rock of Ages Ministries to the 25+ college students in attendance. Upon returning to the field, we hosted our first annual “Lovely Ladies” event at the women’s prison here in New Hampshire where I serve. It was a tremendous blessing to hold three different Christmas services, delivering three gospel messages to the ladies in attendance. All in all, we were able to bless over 100 ladies with a gift package containing a bar of Dove soap, deodorant, a Little Debbie White Christmas tree cake, a Rock of Ages New Testament, and an assortment of Christmas gospel tracts. In **January**, I settled back into our normal prison and school schedules, though new doors continued to open. I was privileged to fill the pulpit for a church here in New England that is currently searching for a pastor. Following that, I traveled to Landmark Baptist Church and College in Florida for a few days. While I was hoping for warmer weather—it was surprisingly cold for Florida!—the fellowship was warm. I was privileged to spend time with the college students, encouraging them as they serve the Lord and presenting the ministry opportunities available through Rock of Ages. It was a blessing to challenge them to consider missionary service—whether with Rock of Ages Ministries or another agency—and to go somewhere to be a pioneer for the cause of Christ. As the Apostle Paul said, **“*Yea, so have I strived to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build upon another man’s foundation:*”** (Romans 15:20). We are truly thankful for your faithful financial support of the work God has entrusted to us here in New England.
