Dear Pine Valley Baptist Church,
“Casting down imaginations, and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bringing into captivity every thought to the obedience of Christ;” This verse has echoed in my mind for the past few weeks, reminding me that even amidst the busyness and pressures of life, God remains in control and has empowered me to manage my thoughts. Recently, during a prison revival, I heard a powerful statement: “God doesn’t make junk!” This truly struck a chord with me. In times when life feels overwhelming, it’s easy to question our worth, to feel like we are less than valuable. However, we must remember that we have the strength to reign in those thoughts because we are made in His image. As the holiday season draws near, I encourage you to embrace this control and depend completely on Him!

Family: The kids had a great time over the past two months as we traveled together to several nearby meetings. We attended a missions conference just outside New York City, where the pastor and his family were incredibly gracious. They took us into the city on the Tuesday of the meeting. Titus had been eager to visit the LEGO store ever since we spotted it during our trip to New York City a couple of years back. The kids were captivated by the LEGO creations, including a life-size taxicab, the Statue of Liberty, the Empire State Building, and several superheroes. They have a piano recital scheduled for December 9, and they are steadily improving as they practice. We needed to return to Georgia for some meetings in November, which allowed us to celebrate Thanksgiving with both of our families while in the area. I’m thrilled to announce that Matthew Jr. will arrive on or around March 15, 2025. We appreciate your prayers for a safe and healthy pregnancy. Several have inquired about ways to celebrate our new baby. To simplify things, we’ve included a QR code on the back of this letter for you to scan with your phone or enter the link directly. There’s no obligation to participate; we’re sharing this information only because of those requests. We are truly grateful for the generosity we’ve experienced from God’s people.

Ministry: October proved to be a remarkable opportunity, as I had the honor of participating in several missions conferences and missions emphasis days throughout the month. We engaged in ministry across the states of Maine, New York, North Carolina, Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and our home state of New Hampshire, actively fulfilling the responsibilities that God has entrusted to us on a daily basis. Our school schedule is in whole progress, alongside our prison schedule. At present, I am privileged to serve at three educational institutions and six correctional facilities on a regular basis. **November** was filled to the brim as we packed in as much as possible into this shorter month. I began by participating in an ordination council for someone at a new supporting church, and later that night, I preached to 54 inmates in prison! After searching for a new rental place and casting my vote in the 2024 presidential election, we boarded a flight to Georgia for several meetings. Our family generously lent us a vehicle while we were there, allowing us to fly instead of drive. While in town, we received the exciting news that we had secured the new place, located just four minutes from my office. After living in Manchester, NH for the past year and a half, where we endured a 25-30 minute commute to work, this was such a blessing. Now, the only task left is to move... After returning from Georgia and participating in several events at our home church – including an anniversary revival meeting, a Christmas parade, and the Christmas tree lighting – we finally made the move! We settled into our new home on November 30, 2024! Although we haven’t unpacked everything, all our belongings are there. ☺ It was an incredibly busy month as we kept to our usual prison and school schedule, even adding a new federal facility into the mix, but it’s all completed now! Over ten people from our home church came to help with loading and unloading the truck, and we are truly grateful for their assistance. **I am beginning to schedule meetings for 2025 if you’d like to schedule an in-person update.** Please contact me via email or text. If a video update is more convenient, let me know. Your prayers and financial support are vital to our ministry’s success. We appreciate your generosity and look forward to staying connected as we serve the Lord in New England.
