This verse is our roadmap for the ministry here in New England, as we strive to do exactly that: let our light shine! In this verse we are instructed to shine, so that others can see, and thereby glorify God. As believers, we have the opportunity to shine our light in a dark world. The light shines the brightest in the darkest place. According to a 2018 Gallup Poll, New England is one of the darkest regions of our country spiritually, surpassing even the West Coast states. We are privileged to serve here where the light of the Gospel is shining brightly!

Family: There's never a dull moment with our family! Little Matthew Jr. is already quite the communicator at three months, delighting everyone with his coos and "conversations," all while bravely navigating the start of teething. Timothy, full of fearless curiosity, is expanding his vocabulary daily, though his adventurous spirit and magnetic appeal to bugs (hello, black flies and mosquitoes!) mean he's often sporting an array of bug bites, scrapes, and bruises – making that new family photo quite the challenge! Meanwhile, Titus and Savannah are enjoying a brief school break, though it'll soon be back to Abeka videos, with Titus focused on catching up to grade level (due to changing back to Abeka) and both tackling Spanish. Titus is also embracing his entrepreneurial side, already mowing lawns with his refurbished mower, and he and Savannah are diligently working together to earn money for Junior Camp, all while continuing to impress with their piano skills.

Ministry: We are incredibly grateful for the tremendous success of our recent National Corrections Week event, made possible by generous donations and faithful support. This outreach allowed us to provide nourishing meals to over 1800 dedicated officers, staff, and volunteers across various correctional facilities. Each meal, consisting of pulled pork, potato salad, baked beans, a Hawaiian sweet roll, chips, and an oatmeal cream pie, served as a tangible expression of appreciation and a powerful Gospel witness. The impact extended beyond the meals, leading to participation in the Rhode Island Department of Corrections Correctional Officer Memorial Service and their subsequent Awards Ceremony, opening new ministry opportunities in Maine and Rhode Island. This monumental achievement would not have been possible without unwavering commitment and support. Looking ahead, we are already planning for Corrections Week 2026, scheduled for May 4-9, 2026, a significant year as we also commemorate America's 250th anniversary. We believe God has even greater things in store and humbly ask for continued partnership, inviting consideration for inclusion in 2026 budgets to expand this vital project. Beyond financial support, we warmly invite volunteers to join us on the ground the week before and the week of the event, offering a remarkable blessing and a chance to see the effects of prayers and generosity firsthand. We finished out May by hosting a prison revival at a men's facility here in New Hampshire. We had old and new volunteers get involved in this meeting, with volunteers coming from SC, PA, CT, and NH. We are thankful to report that five precious souls trusted Christ! **I am scheduling meetings for the upcoming months, and I would love to set up an in-person update with your church!** Just reach out to me through email or text.
