June July 2025

"And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also." This verse points out something vital: we should listen, but also be ready to step up and teach when the moment calls for it. "Commit" means to hand something over with confidence, to trust someone with a task. This is exactly how many churches have treated us—they've trusted us to pass on knowledge to others. We are so privileged to be part of this mission: sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ with others. For me, one of life's greatest joys is the chance to talk about the scriptures with someone. And it's even more satisfying when they not only understand what's being taught but also start teaching others.

Family: My birthday in June (I turned 39 this year!) always makes June special for me, and I'm really grateful for all your cards and texts. Father's Day also falls in June, and honestly, being called "Daddy," "Da," or "Papa" (as my daughter calls me sometimes) is one of life's true joys. We've made sure to squeeze in some family time this summer. We spent a few days together in June while traveling to different meetings stopping to do some fun stuff along the way. In July, our plans include visiting the World Trade Center Memorial and the Flight 93 Memorial as we drive south for the Rock of Ages national conference in Cleveland, Tennessee. Big news from the little ones: Matthew Junior just learned to roll over (a little nerve-wracking, for sure!). Timothy is now putting two or three words together, and Titus and Savannah are loving their summer break. But once we get back from the conference, we'll be diving right back into school.

Ministry: June was a busy month for me, with trips to Rhode Island, New Jersey, and West Virginia for various meetings. I'm thankful for the chance to share the ministry that God has entrusted us with. We're also very grateful to have a **few new financial partners** join us recently, as we've lost some needed financial support as a few churches have changed their missions programs. On a practical note, **we were excited to buy a new-to-us commercial printer, which will be a huge help with all the discipleship lessons we send out. You can find more details about that specific project in the separate letter.** July brought some exciting developments too! I attended a federal training to recertify for another year in the federal facility. During the training, I had a great conversation with the staff member leading it, and he agreed to help us connect with other federal facilities here in New England, including **FCI Berlin** and **FCI Danbury**. I've already spoken with FCI Berlin, and it looks like I'll be able to start working with them when we get back to New England after the Rock of Ages conference. I also got my application started for a new facility in Maine. I'm just waiting to hear back on the background check, but I'm hopeful to begin at all three new facilities once we're back. If you happen to be in the Cleveland, Tennessee area, we'd love for you to join us at the **Rock of Ages national conference**, hosted by Shenandoah Baptist Church. Please be praying for an upcoming **prison revival** happening in **August** at a ladies' facility here in New England. We're also thrilled that God has opened the door for **Bruce Frye** to join us for this revival, as well as for two special services at other facilities in New England while he's in town.
