

The Doctor told me the procedure would take about one hour. The surgery took about two and a half hours, as there was much more damage to my shoulder than expected. I am recuperating, but with much pain. Some have sent cards and kind words along with the promise of prayer, and we are truly grateful.

We are looking forward to returning to Alaska from May 8 through May 19. Gail and I are taking our new Regional Representative, Dr. Jerry Whitlow, to the prisons of Alaska. He will assume direction and begin overseeing this great work. We look forward to seeing this segment of the ministry go forward under his leadership. Please pray for Dr. Whitlow and the ministry in Alaska.

Let me request your prayers as I will be preaching on Mother's Day at the Highland Mountain Correctional Institution for women in Alaska. This institution will house between 400 & 500 women. I have seen as many as 200 plus women come out for the service. We are hopeful that a large portion of the population will come out. Please understand that in prison, when a mother is away from her child or children, this is a lonely time. My hope is to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ, with many souls being saved. Your prayer(s) may make this difference. Dr. Whitlow and I will also be preaching at the Goose Creek Correctional Institution.
