While in Alaska we also survived the "2024 Glitch". We headed for home one day late and just unsure as to how far we might be able to travel. We had a layover in Seattle, WA. Between both Anchorage and Seattle, we were in three lines for over 3 hrs. each. We were just hoping to catch a flight home. This reminds me of what the Bible says many times, "but God". We caught our flight.

At the Hamilton County Jail, we have had no professions of faith. This comes about because of several cancellations and poor attendance in the services we have had held. We are not complaining just asking for your continued prayers.

Gail and I were recently given an unexpected opportunity of preaching at the Lee Aarondale State Prison near Alto, GA. There were well over 100 women in attendance. I enjoyed preaching and the response was 17 women making a professions of faith. Praise the Lord.

She just came through her final surgery on Monday, September 9, 2024. Hopefully, if all goes well she about one week and she will head home.
