As we write our last prayer letter for 2024, Gail and I trust each of you will have a joyous and blessed Holiday Season. We hope you had a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. Gail and I also thank you for your prayers and monthly support. We are truly a blessed couple because of you. Thank you for praying for us and for the wonderful privilege of serving the Lord.

We close out with news concerning one last revival for 2024. The revival was held at the Whitfield Co Jail in Dalton, GA. This is our hometown county jail. The revival was held on December 16 & 17 with a good host of volunteers and Rock of Ages Missionaries. We enjoyed visitation, walking, witnessing, and preaching to the residents. My pastor, Dr. Wayne Cofield preached in a lockdown unit with seven men trusting Christ. Gail was privileged to lead a team into a women's lockdown unit. There were only five women in this unit. She and the team witnessed and Gail gave a devotion. None were saved but they had pleasured knowing the Gospel went forth.

The men in the first unit wherein I led a team were receptive and waiting for us as we walked in. We witness for a while walking from bunk to bunk passing out Gospel tracts and various Rock of Ages materials. A short time passed and we prepared for two red-hot Gospel messages. The men turned down the TV, and a quiet hush filled the dorm. After prayer, one of the volunteers opened the service singing an old song of the faith. It was then that both the residents and our team knew, He had come to speak to all that would listen. The wonderful messages were given. An old-fashioned invitation followed and two men placed their faith in Christ.

On the following night, we entered into an entirely new dorm. When entering the dorms, you never really know what to expect. Sometimes the dorms are quiet and peaceful. At other times it is like a busy street with the men hustling and bustling to and fro and not going anywhere. Things can be loud and disorderly as the dorms seem impossible to preach on. Thanks be to the Lord the men were also respectful and attentive. This time we began with our service first and then visitation. Another young man stepped forward to sing a special song unbeknown to him he sang the same song as was the night before. God met with us a second time in the same manner as the night before. During this service, I used Pastor Warren Adam and he preached with joy. When leaving the dorm four men were gloriously saved. During the revival, sixty-three souls were saved.

Let us leave three prayer requests. In May 2025 I head to Brazil with two other missionaries in our ministry. We will teach and preach to our missionaries along with the possibility of ministering in the prisons. (We now have eight families working with Rock of Ages Ministries in Brazil.) The flight tickets are expensive and I ask that you pray concerning this need. In addition, there will be our lodging, traveling expenses, etc. If possible any additional gift to help with this need is appreciated. (2.) Pray also for Gail and me as we head to Alaska in July. Our team will be in several prisons both male and female institutions. There are also financial needs for this trip. (3.) Finally, let me ask that you look at and consider the enclosed flyer. This is an effectual door of opportunity. Your prayers and gifts are deeply appreciated.
