In May, my wife and I celebrated our 20th wedding anniversary. I am incredibly grateful for the relationship the Lord has allowed us to share. I was able to be in three different prisons in May. The second week of the month I was at a prison in SC. We had a good meeting with 133 inmates attending services and two men making professions of faith. One of the men that made a profession of faith I met on visitation. He said he had been praying for a preacher to visit him. After answering a few of his questions he realized he was lost and trusted Christ as Saviour. I also was able to help two men who were struggling with doubts concerning their salvation. The next week I was at two different prisons one in TN and another in SC. Both meetings had good attendance, with 110 in total attending. We closed out the month attending a mission conference in VA and celebrating my oldest daughter's 14th birthday. Thank you so much for all your prayers and support.
