As we shared with them from the Word of God the bad news that we all have sinned and that the penalty for sin is an eternal separation from God in a lake of fire, tears began to flow. "Now," I said, "let me tell you the good news. God loves you, and He made one way for you to have your sins forgiven." We continued to preach to them Jesus, and a little while later, many teary-eyed people bowed their heads and called on the Lord Jesus for salvation. Glory to God!! Many hugs were passing back and forth from the man and his wife and the people. Everyone was so happy!

We rejoice to report also that several have been coming to Christ in India. Please keep Bro. Isaac and the men there in your prayers as they go about sharing the good news of Jesus Christ. The area in which they live and work is very hostile against Christianity.

We love you all and thank you for all of your faithful prayers and support! May God bless you and your work for Him there, as we work for Him here!
