

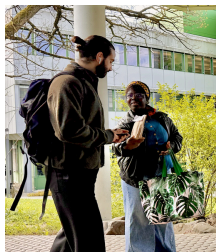

We are living in days of answered prayers! A month ago, God answered our prayers to start a children's ministry and a nursery! Due to our limited space, the nursery and children's church are combined in a small hallway that leads to our restrooms. While this isn't an ideal location, we are thankful to teach truth at the children's level and give parents the chance to listen to God's word undistracted. Please continue to pray that God will provide a new meeting area with enough room to support growth.

God has also answered prayers by continually sending visitors to our church. Church members are meeting people in their everyday lives and are inviting them. God is also using the distribution of our tracts and our website. One visitor is a college student who has just moved here only a few days before church. She shared that her father is a pastor in Romania. She found our church and plans to be a part of it until she finishes her semester in July, when she returns home. Another visitor who is also a Christian is from South Korea. He is also here studying and found us through our website. Not only can we reach souls with the gospel, but we can also provide a place of worship for God's remnant living here or passing through. It is so encouraging to see those living away from home and their church families still seeking to meet with God's people and be part of a local church.

It has been over a year since we began pursuing ways to reach the students at the two universities near our church. In December, our church put together gift bags to hand out when the students returned to their studies. We are overjoyed to share that God has answered our prayer to go onto the university campus. Ten people from our church family passed out 200 bags, each containing practical gifts for the students and gospel tracts. The majority of students were grateful to receive the gifts, and very few refused them. We had encouraging conversations with several students. Many expressed their gratitude to hear that there is a good church in the area that they can attend. Our church members are now burdened to do this outreach again! Before we even left the campus, they were planning the next set of gift bags and other outreach ideas for the students. They also volunteered to help purchase the supplies and take turns manning a table with baked goods. We are excited to see what God will continue to do through his people and his church here! Please pray that souls will be saved, that students will find a church home during their time here, and that God will give us wisdom as we seek to start a college ministry.

We can not let this update go without also praising the Lord for Julie's 16th birthday. She has such a sweet disposition and personality. It is a blessing to see her tender heart for the Lord. Please pray for each of our children as they grow in the Lord.
