### 2 Timothy 1:8a Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord

It is hard to believe that the year is halfway over already! We praise the Lord for all that He continues to do here and the people God allows us to meet. At our Bible study a few weeks ago, one of the men who attends, Clemens, walked in with a visitor. After the Bible study, Tabitha met Anya and was able to talk to her for a long time. Anya said that she doesn't know much about the Bible, but she listened as Tabitha shared the gospel and the goodness of God to His children. Please pray that God will use that conversation in Anya's heart. There have been several other people with whom we have been able to engage in gospel conversations. Please pray that God will use those seemingly small interactions, and these people will put their faith in Jesus Christ.

In May, we had the opportunity to FaceTime a 4th-grade class. Tabitha's sister works at a Christian school and invited us to share what God has called us to do here. Lord willing, we will be able to get her situated in her dorm before the rest of our family returns to Germany. While this will be extremely hard for us all, we have such peace from the Lord!
