Greetings in the lovely name of our glorious Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. As we head into our 6<sup>th</sup> year of ministry here in Papua New Guinea, we are humbled to see all that the Lord has done. God has indeed been so good to allow us to have a part in His work, and we are so very thankful for the support and prayers that you all have provided for us all this time.

Many have asked us when we plan to come back for a furlough, and after much prayer, we believe that the Lord would have us continue here in Papua New Guinea for the time being. Much of the work here is still in the beginning stages and we believe that a lengthy absence at this time would not be beneficial. **Please pray with us that the Lord will continue to establish the work here in His timing and give us the direction necessary to properly plan a visit back to the USA.**

In January, we were blessed to be able to spend 10 days in Cairns, Australia enjoying some time as a family resting/relaxing and catching up on some needed doctor's appointments. We had a great time enjoying foods and treats that we don't usually get to enjoy here in PNG, as well as enjoying the nature and sights. Sheila and our three oldest boys (Donovan, Marshall, and Jeremiah) even got to enjoy a snorkeling trip to the Great Barrier Reef!! We are thankful for this short time away, and the rest we were able to get during this time.

**Highlands Baptist Bible Institute:** On March 2<sup>nd</sup>, we were excited to start another year of classes at our Bible School here in Mount Hagen. This semester, I am teaching 4 classes (*Genesis, 1 Thessalonians, Theology, and New Testament Survey*). It is a blessing to see several new students from all over the region enroll in classes this semester. **Please pray for our students to stay faithful in their studies and grow in "grace and knowledge of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ."**

**Kelua Ministry:** The work in Kelua continues to go forward at Open Bible Baptist Church. A young man (Nehemiah) who has been visiting our services for some time approached me after a Wednesday evening service with a desire to be born again. **After showing him from Scriptures how to be saved, he bowed his head and called upon the Lord to save him!!**

We have also had quite a few visitors come to our services, many of them returning week after week. **Many of these folks have admitted to being under conviction and have recognized that they are not born again. Please pray for the Lord to continue to work in their lives and for these folks to be saved in the days to come.**

This last week, we were able to start our weekly Bible classes at the local primary school in Kelua. This open door allows us to share the Scriptures with 1500+ students every week. Many of our new converts, Bible school students, and some of the brethren from Temple Baptist Church in Mount Hagen have joined in these efforts to help minister to these young people.

The work on our church property continues to go forward as well. We have purchased a large tree and will begin milling it into lumber to construct our new Church building as well as toilet facilities and a Sunday School building. Please pray for this work to go forward without delay. We are so thrilled to see our new Christians investing their time, money, and hard work into establishing a church in their community.
