Before our departure, we took a brief eleven-day journey across the U.S. for two Missions Conferences. Our first stop was at Lighthouse Baptist Church in Horseheads, New York, where we enjoyed a wonderful mission revival alongside a few dozen regional pastors—what a blessed week! We then headed west to Pasco, Washington, spending a few special days with Riverview Baptist Church. Their pastor, John Paisley, is always a joy to be around. We were warmly welcomed at the airport by my dad and a kind couple from our church, who helped us back from the airport. Family & Ministry Update - "Settling In"


