Hosting USA Laborers: We've had the joy of welcoming three visiting groups already this summer, beginning with Pastor Lamb and his team from Landmark Baptist Church in Parkersburg, West Virginia. In their short time with us, they were a great blessing—five souls were saved, and our Sunday morning teen class was launched! They also helped assemble our studio equipment, which we plan to use for recording Bible-teaching segments next month.

Next, we welcomed the Pierce family from Linton, Indiana. They ministered through music, helped in the children's class, distributed Gospel invitations door to door, and more. What a gift it is to see families serving Jesus together!

Missionary Evangelist James Belisle joined us for our Men's Day Out, where 21 men and lads enjoyed fellowship over a museum visit and fish and chips. He preached both services the next day, and the church was truly encouraged.

Soul Report: After spending the last 10 years abroad, I've noticed what seems to be a growing openness to the Gospel here in England. Many, especially within my generation, are searching, perhaps more than ever before. One example is Abby. While witnessing in the city center on a Saturday morning, I shared the Gospel with two of her coworkers. Abby sat down beside them, listened intently, and eagerly prayed to accept Christ. Before leaving, she shared that just the day before, she had asked God to reveal His purpose to her. She said to me, "There must be more to life than working my job." Since then, she's been coming to church, and we're planning to begin discipleship with her in the coming weeks. ***In the past 2 months, we've witnessed to 17 souls, with 6 accepting Christ.***
