# **Return to Taiwan**

We're thrilled to announce that we'll be purchasing plane tickets in February for our family's return to Taiwan this July! Several friends have asked about contributing toward our travel costs. For our family of six, the total expense will be approximately \$7,000, with additional costs for setting up a new home once we arrive. The Lord has always provided for these needs, and we trust He will do so again.

# **Goals for the Next Term**

Our vision for this term is twofold:

- Ministry: We are asking God to multiply our church plants, doubling their number, and to establish a growing 1. community of full-time pastors and interns. We pray that the Lord Jesus will do exceedingly abundantly above all we can ask or think.
- Family: Our oldest son, Ian, is entering middle school and has special needs. We are trusting God as we transition to 2. homeschooling him with some hired help. I've been taking ABA behavioral training classes to better support Ian, and I'm praying this training will allow us to minister to other families with special needs, opening doors to share the Gospel. Please continue to pray for Ian and the salvation of all our children.

#### **Updates from Taiwan**

Pastor Sam of Second Mile Baptist Church recently baptized a young man who was saved last month—praise the Lord! Second Mile Baptist is looking at three properties for purchase, with \$40,000 of the \$150,000 needed to make an offer. A building purchase would reduce their monthly expenses significantly. Vision Baptist Mission is organizing donations to help. Would you pray with us for this need?

God has been at work in Shawnee. A young man we met at a pizzeria attended our Bible study and, on his second visit, prayed to receive Christ as his Savior and Lord.
