We are thankful to have our van fixed after the accident. It was around \$1,700 to repair and replace everything. Everything seems to be working well. We praise God no one was hurt in the accident and that we were able to have the van repaired.

Schools in Mongolia are back in session. With the schools open the traffic is much worse. On top of the increased traffic, the local elections were held on October 11th. For the past few weeks, the city has decided to repair and repave many of the roads in town causing more delays. It took us two hours to get to church one Wednesday evening which normally would take us around 30 minutes.

Faith Baptist Bible College will be having our mid-term test in a couple of weeks. I have enjoyed our study of 1 & 2 Corinthean and Hermeneutics. The students are also studying the Biblical principles of Music and Theology 1 taught by one of our graduates/Mongolian pastors. Our translator/teacher has recovered from her surgery and has returned to translating and teaching. We are thankful her surgery went better than expected. Please continue to pray for the students and staff as they continue to study God's Word and prepare to be good servants for Him.

Our church is still seeking a permanent home. We desire to buy property with a building on it or the ability to build. While we are waiting on God's direction we are continuing to rent our current location. It was time to renew our year contract with the owner. We did not want to sign a contract because we are wanting to move. I praise God that the owner agreed to let us pay month to month without a contract. He had asked that we give him a month's notice before we move. Please pray that God would give us wisdom in finding a permanent home for our church.

Our church is doing well. Many of our people are growing in their relationship with God. We have started a Bible study on Wednesday nights where we have a discussion around God's Word on different topics. My desire is to study some of the things that Mongolian christians face in their lives and culture. Please pray for wisdom in these studies.

I am back to teaching English. I teach 6th and 7th grades four days every week. It takes about 5 hours of my time in the middle of those days total including travel. I am thankful for this opportunity because it provides me a visa. Please pray that God will use me to be a good testimony to the students and teachers.

This year our fourth child, Charlie, will turn 18 on december 1st. When he turns 18 he no longer can be in the country under my visa. We are wanting to transfer his visa to a student visa until next summer. This can be done if we enroll him in a Mongolian language school. Please pray for this process.
