This delay caused us to not be together for Thanksgiving. Our family was spread out for thanks giving. Our daughters were in two different cities in Florida. Our oldest son and his family were in New Hampshire. Tammy and Charlie were in S. Korea and Clay and I were here in Mongolia. We are thankful we were all able to be together through technology for a few minutes. Charlie is now under a tourist visa for three months and then we will have to decide what is next. We have looked at several properties for a new location for our church. It has been difficult because the properties in the city are expensive. We ask that you pray that God would allow us to find the right property, location and price. We need to relocate as the rent at our current location is difficult to maintain. We are thankful that our current landlord has agreed to allow us to pay month to month without a contract.

Faith Baptist Bible College will finish this semester in December. Prayerfully, we will have our second graduation in May or June of 2025. We are working with four students for this graduation. We had four other students that were studying with us this semester. Two of them, a mother and daughter, had to postpone their studied due to difficulties in their lives. Please pray for them as they both had emergency appedectomies within a couple months of each other. We are asking God to continue to use this ministry to prepare christians for their service to Christ.
