Dear Pastor and Church,

October 2024

Greetings! We are still having wonderful weather! It is still raining and the weather has stayed relatively cool, since our July prayer letter.

Updates/praise reports: A fairly new ministry, many of our churches have started or are trying is Kids Clubs. This has really jump started some of our churches. We are doing it in addition to visitation, not instead of visitation. Our 2 Conferences at the end of July went very nicely. All these years with the ladies, we have encouraged people to bring lost people, but it was more a meeting to encourage established Christian ladies. This year we had a lot of lost people and new ladies. Many of these ladies were mothers of the children coming to the clubs. Our Pastors Conference turned out really well too. Even though the whole theme is encouraging people in the ministry, we had 3 people saved. Our churches also had VBS all over Mexico, with souls saved. Bill's health is improving and he has more strength, praise the Lord! He has preached 2 Missions Conferences and a Mission Emphasis Sunday. We saw Faith Promise increased in each one, Mt. Abarim Baptist Church in Zimatlan, Oaxaca, doubled their Faith Promise and had people saved in the meeting. We got 4 vans in, since the last letter. It is funny, the pastors just take the vans arriving for granted, but when they have to make the trip to the border, it is a different story. Some of them were very scared waiting around in Reynosa for Bill to drive the vans back across, also driving past all the checkpoints. They also asked to stay in a church in Reynosa, because of it taking so long to get it all done. No one wants to be in Reynosa or traveling after dark. The Institute has started back up with around 30 students. Bro. Jose Camacho's death really affected people. 16 new students are attending from Memorial Baptist Church. We are also having packed services, especially every Sunday night. We are having visitors in almost every service and souls saved in services and visitation. Another big praise is we received the fund to repair our tabernacle floor. Now we just have to get busy and do it.

We are still facing many funerals. We guess there just comes a time in your life when this is normal. Our pastors, Bro. Toribio (Toro) Quiroz daddy died Saturday, 11/12 and Bro. Jose & Julio Gonzalo daddy passed away this morning 11/15. Many of you know them from your trips down here.

As always we thank you for your love, prayers, faithful support. We also thank you that call and write. It is such an encouragement.
