I just got back from visiting our missionaries in San Miguel de Tucumán, Argentina, Joshua and Abigail Owens. Along with their son, Matthew, they are doing a great work for the Lord. Joshua has been doing double duty for the last few months. His father, Missionary Larry Owens, is in the states on furlough and Joshua is holding down the fort at his father's church, as well as working at his own church in the city of Terma, located about an hour and a half from Tucumán.



RAISING THE ROOF – Thank you for praying for the building project at the church in Terma. The Lord graciously provided the necessary funds for the church to raise the roof and shortly, the people of the Zion Hill Baptist Church will be able to start meeting in their new building. God is so Good!



REACHING THE LOST – On Thursdays and Fridays Joshua heads up an evangelistic team that goes out to reach the people of Terma. He has a good group of serious servants who work with him to win souls. On the Saturday night service, Joshua and his team of co-workers, brought in about 140 people to hear the Word of God and five people made the decision to trust Christ.



BRINGING THEM IN – On Sunday morning we were back in Tucumán for the services at the Bethel Baptist Church. They have a large group of bus workers who go out into the highways and hedges to bring in lost souls. We had tremendous services with beautiful singing. After the Sunday night service, one of the workers told me that they had over 80 first-time visitors and that 30 people made the decision to trust Christ as Savior.

Thank you for your faithful prayers and support for our ministry. We praise the Lord for all that you do for His service.
