Dear Pine Valley Baptist Church,

“That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world.” (John 1:9). As I write this letter, I am enjoying a peaceful moment between Sunday services, sitting near the Bug Light in South Portland, Maine. In just a bit, I'll head down the road to see the iconic Portland Head Light again. Listening to the waves and taking in the beauty of these lighthouses beautifully reminds me of John 1:9. The scripture shares how John the Baptist came not to be the light, but to bear witness to the true Light! To "bear witness" simply means to provide evidence or testify. Just like John, our role is to be a faithful testifier and point people to the Lord. The light always shines the brightest in the darkest places, and what a profound privilege it is to bear witness to His light here in New England!

Family: It has been a busy season of birthdays for our family! Titus just turned 12 on March 15, Timothy turned 3 in February, and Matthew Jr. celebrated his first birthday on March 8. We want to send a heartfelt thank you to everyone who sent birthday cards, letters, and gifts for the boys—your kindness is such a blessing! Titus is a quarter of the way through 6th grade and doing well. Savannah is moving quickly through her school year and might even be finished by Corrections Week. She isn't the biggest fan of the multiplication and division she's learning right now, but she absolutely loves science! Timothy is officially potty-trained and eagerly waiting for warmer weather to ride his Paw Patrol bike. He loves being outdoors and is great at watching out for his little brother. For Matthew Jr., time has flown by since we brought him home! He is walking now, cutting his one-year molars, and loves relaxing in his rocking chair. Lastly, Hannah has been pushing through a toothache recently, but we are looking forward to getting it fixed with a crown as soon as insurance gives the green light.

Ministry: God has been opening some incredible doors across New England! In February, we hit the ground running with plans for National Corrections Week (May 4-9). We finalized the design for the special challenge coins we are gifting the officers this year; they are officially ordered and should arrive by mid-April! It was also a busy month filled with great strides on several ongoing projects, and we can't wait to share those details with you soon once the final

preparations are complete. March brought even more exciting news as we continued reaching into the "next town"—or in our case, the next prison! I am so thankful for a chaplain whom God used to help push my application through, finally granting us access to the state of Connecticut. We also saw a massive breakthrough in Vermont! On March 31, I had the privilege of holding the first Rock of Ages Ministries service in a Vermont prison in over 15 years. God truly orchestrated it all! We had 15 men attend, and several eagerly asked when I would be returning. Even better, the Volunteer Coordinator is sending an email with a letter of recommendation on my behalf to all the other Vermont facilities! We are so incredibly thankful for the opportunity to serve the Lord and partner with all of you as we labor here. Would you please pray with us for the upcoming National Corrections Week events? I have been given the profound honor of providing the invocation and benediction at a memorial service for Correctional Officers who have died in the line of duty, and I will also be participating in their awards ceremony later in the week. Only God can open doors like these! Keep loving people and keep telling them about Jesus!

We are so incredibly thankful for your faithful financial support of our ministry here in New England. Thank you for continually partnering with us to reach the lost!
