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Dear Pine Valley Baptist Church,

“And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.” We are coming up on six years of ministry here in New England. It hasn't always been easy as we've labored to open up doors in the local prisons and schools. However, thanks to the Lord's mercies and His help in keeping us faithful, we are slowly beginning to reap a harvest. We are finally gaining access to facilities that, until recently, had been closed to us the entire time we've been here. We are so thankful for your prayers that we wouldn't grow weary, because God is truly allowing us to see the increase.

Family Update: Titus has really been kicking it into high gear on the piano recently! He and Savannah both had a great recital to close out their lessons for the school year. He is still working hard on finishing up sixth grade, but he's making good progress and should be all set to start seventh grade in the fall. Savannah has already finished her schoolwork and is taking full advantage of the wonderful New England weather—whether she's crafting outside or admiring all the flowers in the yard.

Timothy is talking a lot more now, keeping us laughing with his mischievous sense of humor and all his new words. He has grown so much that he's almost ready to ditch the balance bike for one with training wheels, and then it's off to the races! Speaking of off to the races, Matthew Junior is officially running now! He is saying simple words like "mama," "dada," and "bye-bye," and he easily gets his point across by pointing and grunting for what he wants.

Lastly, Hannah finally got her dental crown put on after a lot of back-and-forth with the insurance company. However, she still has several more that need to be taken care of, so please make this a matter of prayer.

Ministry: April Update

I had the opportunity to preach two special Easter services in a Maine prison. We had record crowds out! I preached to a different group of men than usual, with 21 in attendance, and they all requested that I come back to do another service. On the women's side, we had 15 women attend, which was also a record. I am currently working with the chaplain to see how we can collaborate on future efforts before he transfers to another facility. **Please keep this in your prayers.**

The Saturday after Easter, I traveled to North Carolina to report in at a couple of churches and to finalize my training for the public school systems. Over the last four years, I have been faithfully working with three alternative schools to gain experience, as this was a brand-new type of ministry for us before moving to New England. As of the end of April, I am officially cleared to begin working in public schools here! **Please pray that God guides me to the right schools** that will allow me to bring the *Character Under Construction* program to their students.

May Update: May was easily one of the biggest months of ministry we've had all year. God blessed in a mighty way, providing incredible volunteers who stayed up many late nights to make this year's event a reality. We were privileged to minister to over 2,400 officers, staff members, and volunteers, and we even expanded into four brand-new facilities! ***My contact at a facility in Vermont mentioned that he has been in corrections for over 30 years and had never seen a volunteer group do something specifically for the staff.***

Then, at one of our new facilities in Maine, an officer told me that we had “the best challenge coin in the DOC.” He was so enthusiastic that he went on to announce our church services three different times over the loudspeaker. Because of that, we had 12 men come out to the service—nearly doubling our usual attendance of 6 or 7!

In addition to our normal prison schedule, we finished out the month by providing pulpit supply for a local pastor who was away. We also finalized preparations for the prison revival that took place June 6-7, 2026, in Northern New Hampshire.
