We had a “to-do” list upon arrival, which included things such as: finding a house for our family, making contacts and friends, taking care of an important surgery for Alaine, renewing our visas to Mozambique and starting Bible studies to generate interest in a church plant. **We rejoice that the Lord has been so gracious to allow these things to come to pass in His unique way.** The Lord opened a door for us to rent a small location for Liberty Baptist Church to meet. It is a 6-month lease with the opportunity to extend if needed. We are also hoping to begin a deaf church in the future on Sunday evenings. We would like to meet at the same property. We are continuing to grow little by little in our knowledge of SASL (South African Sign Language). There is much to pray and work towards! Our first official service will be on June 7th however, we will have Bible studies until then.

Gospel Opportunities

We are thankful for the arrival of 60,000 gospel tracts sent to us with the help of Micah McCurray and Bible Tracts Inc. This will greatly help in evangelism! Sunday we went to a village to preach at Grace Baptist Church about an hour and half away from from our city. It was a joyful time together with Pastor Orlando Khosa and **we rejoice with the one soul who trusted Christ as their personal Savior following the service.** Also, we can report a praise about our Mozambican visas being renewed for another year. Due to the high cost and seeking the Lord’s direction, we opted to renew the visas of Noah and Logan this year. Tris and the girls can still visit several times a year under a different visa. This will be more practical for their season of life. We are so grateful to you, our friends in the gospel!
