Praise The Lord! We Are Not Alone!

Hebrews 13:5 says, "I will never leave thee nor forsake thee." We are never alone!

When Jesus was preparing to return to His Father in heaven after His crucifixion and resurrection, He promised His disciples in John 14:18, "I will not leave you comfortless: I will come unto you".

Jesus fulfilled this promise when He sent the Holy Spirit to live in the heart of every believer. He said this wonderful Spirit would be our comforter, our guide, our teacher...and that He would seal us for Christ until "the day of redemption"...that is until the day Christ returns as He promised to receive us unto Himself.

However in John 14:21, Jesus went on to say that those who keep His commandments would experience the "manifestation" of Christ in their lives. That is, they would feel His presence. This is conditional.

Romans 8:1 tells us to "walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit". Verse 5 says that if we mind fleshly things, we will be carnally minded, and that "the carnal mind is enmity against God". We cannot walk with God and experience His closeness if we walk contrary to His commandments.

In summary:

- Jesus told us not to be troubled by the fact that He would leave earth, go back to heaven, prepare a place for us, and then return again in what we call the Rapture.
- He promised that in the meantime, He would send the Holy Spirit, the very Spirit of Christ Himself,

to live inside us...to comfort, guide, teach, and seal us until "the day of redemption".

It is a fact that this wonderful Spirit of Promise lives inside every believer just as Jesus promised. He is a resident in our hearts... so we indeed are never alone.

However, for Him to "manifest" Himself...that is for us to sense His presence day by day, we must cooperate with Him. We must strive to walk with Him.

How can we do this? By reading our Bible, praying, attending a good Bible preaching church, by fellowshiping with other Christians, and by witnessing to those who do not know Him.

As we do these things, we will find ourselves walking with Him.

And we will sense the truth that we truly are never alone!
