

Dear pastors and praying friends,

This letter is a little late, but that is only because we have been up to our eyeballs in the work here and I just haven't made time to sit down and write this letter. Here's a review on our February (and half of march by this point) and what the Lord is doing.

### **Church and Building Update**

Back in December, which is when our summer starts, and things slow down here, I had prayed and asked the Lord to get us in a new building by the end of February, which is the end of summer vacation. March is when things pick back up, and everyone comes back from vacation, so I really wanted to be in a bigger, more centrally located, building by then. On Feb 29, we had our first service in the new building! Praise the Lord. Everyone is very happy about it, and we are all excited to see how the Lord will use it.

We had our first ladies meeting, where the women got together, sang, ate, and had a Bible message. We invited the wife of a Chilean pastor to come teach, and she did a great job. Her husband will be preaching our men's meeting later this month on the 29th, so please pray for that as well.

Our launch service is going to be March 24, and in the 3 weeks leading up to that, we are working to tag 6,000 houses with an invitation. So the 6,000 houses nearest the church will get 3 different invitations to the church. We have already had 1 visitor from those efforts, praise the Lord. We have also been working hard on social media to invite people, and as we are out inviting people, several folks have mentioned they recognized me from social media! We are praying for these moments to turn into visitors, and salvation decisions. Please pray with us!

We are also working on raising money to buy a building of our own. We are trying to raise 125,000 dollars which would be enough to cover the building, and any remodeling that would be necessary, Lord willing.
